We held several events **serving 398 families and 110 crime victims in 2021**. In-person events were tremendously impacted this year; however, our **Youth Ambassador Leadership Education (Y.A.L.E.)** students still managed to earn 538 servicelearning volunteer hours, completed 15 service projects, and interviewed for several scholarships. We were delighted to host our **5th Annual Banquet** in-person with 130 attendees to celebrate our students. 
