

## Scholarships and Awards Application

In 2023, the Family Life and Community Resource Center (FLCRC) will present several scholarships and awards to outstanding students. Recipients must demonstrate academic potential, leadership, and a commitment to community service. FLCRC's mission is to *Build Better Communities by Building Stronger Families*. A significant part of our program services are focused on youth and addressing their individual needs to strengthen the family.

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- ▶ To be eligible to apply for the FLCRC Outstanding Senior Scholarship, Hildred Jones-Drain Scholarship, and Dakota Merriweather Scholarship, the applicant must be a first-time recipient and a Texas high-school graduating senior in the 2023-2024 school year.
- ➤ To be eligible to apply for the Y.A.L.E. Leader of the Year Scholarship, FLCRC Outstanding Student Scholarship, and FLCRC Service Learning Scholarship, the applicant must be a first-time recipient and a Y.A.L.E. member.
- ▶ To be eligible to apply for the **FLCRC Outstanding College Student Scholarship**, the applicant must be a first-time recipient, a Y.A.L.E. member and a current college student.
- ▶ To be eligible to apply for the **Pre-Y.A.L.E. Emerging Leader Award** and **Pre-Y.A.L.E. Service Learning Award**, the applicant must be a first-time recipient and Pre-Y.A.L.E. member.
- ▶ To be eligible to apply for any scholarships or awards, the applicant must not have a balance owed to FLCRC.

#### **Applicants must:**

- 1. Provide a copy of transcript/report card and SAT/ACT score if available.
- 2. Turn in your completed Y.A.L.E. portfolio at the FLCRC office on or before Monday, October 31, 2023.
- 3. Attend an in-person interview on **Saturday, November 4, 2023 between 9:30 a.m. and 12 noon**.
- 4. Complete and email this application to <a href="mailto:info@familylifecrc.org">info@familylifecrc.org</a> by 4:30 p.m. on Monday, October 31, 2023. FLCRC will not accept or consider any incomplete or late applications. No exceptions will be made.
- 5. Attend FLCRC's Scholarships and Awards Ceremony on Saturday, December 2, 2023 at 6:00 p.m.
